Having a fleet comprised entirely of inherited locomotives, Amtrak had former Penn Central E8A #4316 painted in a special blue and black livery to commemorate their first day of operations. Like their locomotives, all of Amtrak's rolling stock was inherited from other railroads and it took many years for uniform branding to be painted on the entire fleet. This resulted in a colorful rainbow-like appearance on Amtrak trains throughout the 1970s.
